Reporting to the lyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma r' \Delta^{,2}$ "Wisdom" Program Team Lead as the direct supervisor; the lyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma r' \Delta^{,2}$ "Wisdom" Program Urban Youth Outreach Worker supports case management activities within the lyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma r' \Delta^{,2}$ "Wisdom" Program. The key role for the lyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma r' \Delta^{,2}$ Program Urban Youth Outreach Worker is to engage in activities that help young people develop important life skills, build confidence, and foster positive relationships. - Support Youth Access to programming that strengthens life skill development;
- Develop professional trusting relationships with the Youth;
- Establish connections with external programs that support the goals of each youth within the lyinisowin $\Delta r \sigma d \Delta \sigma$ "Wisdom" Program; and
- Participate in team lead discussions and planning to support the operations of the lyinisowin ムトゥイム・[>] "Wisdom" Program.

The Iyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma A \Delta^{.2}$ Program Urban Youth Outreach Worker is a key team member and may be asked to carry out additional duties and activities related to the effectiveness and successful implementation of the Iyinisowin $\Delta \lambda \sigma A \Delta^{.2}$ "Wisdom" Program.

- A post-secondary certificate or diploma in Human Services, Youth Worker, Social Work, and/or applicable certificates and/or 5 years of experience working with Young Adults.
- Experience using trauma informed care and harm reduction practices;
- Availability to provide services to young adults on weekdays, evenings, and weekends to accommodate the needs of clients; and
- An understanding of the dynamics and demographics of First Nation communities.
